SURVIVE-MIVA

This Weekend we are taking up a Collection for *SURVIVE-MIVA*. Christopher Cooke will give a short outline of the work at the end of each Mass.

SURVIVE-MIVA is a Catholic lay Association, whose patron is the Archbishop of Liverpool. They exist to provide one vital element for successful pastoral, health, development and educational work in developing countries – *mobility*. There are over 100 members, the vast majority Catholic lay men and women from all walks of life who give generously of their time to make appeals for funds at parishes throughout Scotland, Wales and England.

There is a staff of six (three full-time, two part-time and one volunteer) based in the Liverpool office who are involved in raising funds e.g. through administering the appeals carried out by volunteer Speakers, and processing applications for transport grants, which originate from Central and South America, Africa and Asia.
