#### What new translation?

The translation of the Mass which we currently use is going to change from the beginning of September. Over the coming months there will be short articles in the Newsletter each week which will help us to understand what these changes are and why they have come about. There will be plenty of opportunities provided for people to learn more about the new translation and become familiar with the changes. A number of day and evening sessions are being arranged for those who would like to find out more, as well as specific sessions for those involved in, for example, music. A variety of printed resources will be available, including the new responses for Mass. The coming of the new translation is a great opportunity for us all to learn more about the Mass and deepen our understanding of the liturgy and its meaning and relevance for us in our lives today.
