21st April 2014 - 4th Sunday of Easter

Dear friends,

A very warm welcome to Our Lady Help of Christians. The focus for the readings this weekend is on Jesus, the Good Shepherd. In the passage from John's Gospel, Jesus repeatedly calls himself the Good Shepherd, a shepherd who is prepared to lay down his life for his sheep.

This Sunday is The Day of Prayer for Vocations, and we are encouraged to pray for vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life. While the emphasis is on vocations to the Priesthood and the Religious life, it is also an opportunity for us as individuals and as a community to reflect on our relationship with Jesus and His personal invitation and call to be a disciple.

Our primary vocation is to Love – to love God and those around us perfectly. From that start point, each one of us has a unique vocation from God; each of us is called to proclaim the Good News and carry God's love to all those we encounter in the wider community. Vocations to marriage, to ordained ministries and to the religious life are all necessary to the mission of God's Church. Through our Baptism we are called to serve. How do I respond to that call?

Here I am, Lord
Is it I, Lord?
I have heard You calling in the night
I will go, Lord
If You lead me
I will hold Your people in my heart.

This weekend we welcome Bro. Sixtus and Bro Reuben, who are students studying for the Priesthood. They will be speaking at our Parishes in Farnborough about their vocation. I am sure you will give them a warm welcome. We are also fortunate that Bro Martin, another student for the priesthood, is currently working at the Salesian College and in the Parish. This weekend there is the annual collection for the Clergy Training Fund. The Fund looks after the training of students for the priesthood in our Diocese. The Fund also supports the ongoing formation of our ordained priests.
