# 28th April 2014 - 5th Sunday of Easter

### Dear friends,

A very warm welcome to Our Lady Help of Christians.

We give thanks for all the blessings our good Lord is sending us during this season of Easter, and we now look forward to the month of May, a month traditionally dedicated to our Lady.

Our readings this weekend challenge us to reflect on how we as individuals, as disciples, as a Community, respond to God's love for us. The first reading describes how Saul the persecutor, Paul the Apostle, committed to the spread of the gospel. In the second reading, John encourages us to translate the relationship we have with God into deeds.

In the passage from John's Gospel, Jesus uses the image of a grapevine and its branches to emphasise the importance of living our lives in and through Him. We are called to remain always in Christ, nurturing each other in faith and love, so that we can together bear the fruit of God's transforming love to the people of our world today. We are united to Jesus and His life flows into us: our relationship with Him must then necessarily overflow in our commitment to others. building up Christ's Body, the Church.

# DAY OF PRAYER FOR VICTIMS AND SURVIVORS OF ABUSE - 30th April 2024
